When subtracted from our beginning balance of \$2,031.32 leaves the MGCC with an ending balance of \$1891.43 in the primary checking account. The Savings account currently has \$380.56. Total ending balance of all accounts was \$2,271.99. Skip Peterson motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report. Mike Edgerton seconded. Eddie never opposes money.

Activities with Eddie. "There's the Labor Day Parade. There was a note that went out. Contact Skip if

At some point we're going to need an MG Food Truck. Terry & Carole are above and beyond with tables, truck, ice cream, etc. There were people from Champaign, Illinois, Pennsylvania, and a couple of other places." Dave G. "We're waiting on the bill from Rumpke, and White Allen's sponsorship check."

Other Old Business. The MGCC Picnic, "Thanks Terry & Carole for hosting. Perhaps the engineer who ran the train might want to consider hosting next year." Skip, "That was me." Jennifer, "No." Skip, "Our backyard's big enough."

Dave Gribler, "Concours. It's 3-weeks away (tomorrow as of typing). Everything is looking good and on track. I'm nervous, but I'm always nervous."

New Business. Dave G. "I'd like to continue the discussion that we started last meeting on raising our dues. We were fortunate at BCD that we had a good year, but there's no question that prices have gone up. Our Treasury has been dwindling down. Is it time to raise our dues." Terry Looft, "I'd suggest an even \$20 so that we don't have to make change." Skip, "I joined in 1991 and it was \$18 dues then. They first time I was President, we had \$400 in the bank account." Sam Hodges, "I just ran the numbers. That \$18 in 1991 would equate to \$34.00 with cost of living adjustments." Dave, "I'm just going to leave this here and let the next President deal with it. Carole Looft, "If we don't do anything about it now, we're essentially tabling it until next year since dues are due next month." Skip, "That's fine, since we've got some money. We can take a long hard look at it to see if it makes sense." Eddie, "If we do raise the dues, what are we thinking?" Jennifer Peterson & Lois Gribler both, "\$25.00". Carole, "After looking at the bylaws, there's nothing in here about the amount, but the proration is here. Therefore, we'd probably have to make a change to the bylaws based on the proration of \$1.50/month."

Tabling the issue, President Dave, "Moving on. Fall Drive. If we do this the way that we've done these things in the past, such as the Picnic, Ron Parks is planning our Fall Drive." Skip & Terry, "I'm good with that." MGCC Voted. Ron Parks is planning our Fall Drive.
